



## The DRFWA Alex Cohen Diabetes Scholarship

### Additional Regulations

The DRFWA has made available a sum of money from the Alex Cohen Diabetes Scholarship Fund for the purpose of providing top-up scholarships to students in receipt of an APA conducting research based around clinical, cause, complications or psychological aspects of any form of diabetes at the University of Western Australia (UWA). Collaborative research is encouraged.

Funds will be available for the duration of an APA up to 75% of the award.

Additional to the UWA Ad Hoc Scholarship regulations, the recipients must –

- ✚ Report to the DRFWA annually on the progress of the research
- ✚ Recipients will be invited to deliver a presentation relating to the research at the DRFWA World Diabetes DAY event in November each year
- ✚ Recipients will also be given the opportunity to conduct interviews with the media in relation to the scholarship/research project
- ✚ On completion of the scholarship submit to the DRFWA all published papers relating to the research
- ✚ Acknowledge funding from DRFWA Alex Cohen Diabetes Scholarship in all presentations, papers and media coverage
- ✚ Give approval for the use by DRFWA of the recipient's name and field of research in publicity material and web site content. Provide data that the researcher agrees will not compromise the final publication of research results for use in DRFWA research updates and web publicity.
